*As members of our **Community Supported Agriculture (CSA)** program you can expect the best of the farm harvest each week of the season. By joining as a CSA member and paying in advance of the season, you help cover spring farm expenses as they are incurred, allow us to dedicate our time mid-season growing food rather than marketing, and commit to sharing in the loss if there are major crop failures due to weather, injury or pests.*

Eating from a CSA share is a surprise each week and a joy for those who love to cook. Be ready to try new vegetables. Be excited for a culinary challenge that truly supports a healthy diet and the viability of a local farm. Be assured that the food from Welcome Table Farm is grown without the use of any chemical pesticides, herbicides or fertilizers. We grow clean food by improving soil health. We choose not to obtain Organic Certification but welcome the questions and visits of our customers at any time. Come visit!

There are several changes of note for our 2012 season.

The past couple of seasons we have struggled to fill our early season boxes as we've met with seasonal delays due to cold, wet weather. At the same time we've had excess produce in the weeks following the end of the CSA season. For 2012 we're going to try to better match our growing season with the CSA season. Boxes will start in mid-June and run through the week of Thanksgiving. There will be no "Extended Season Share."

Pick-up locations have not yet been determined. Please check your preference on the registration form and we will confirm with you in May. Interested in hosting a pick-up location? Please talk with us!

The **BIG** farm news is that we're buying our own place! For the last 5 years we've leased our current location on Mill Creek Rd as we've honed our farming skills, collected equipment, and searched for the perfect home and land package to buy. We've found our dream in 25 acres and an old farmstead on Old-Milton

Highway (1/2 way between Plaza Way and Hwy 11 in WA). In 2012 we'll be working hard to provide you with quality produce as we transition from our Mill Creek site to the new location. We'll be seeding pasture and cover crop, planning perennials, putting up animal fencing, repairing the root cellar, building a proper wash station, raising two new hoop houses and a propagation greenhouse. As we invest in our future of growing food for you- we invite you to do the same. Capital gifts and loans from our loyal farm members would go a long ways in this transition. CSA Box- Full Share:

The weekly mix of farm fresh bounty includes salad greens, cooking greens, roots, alliums, fresh herbs, berries, and other vegetables. Feeds a household of four, or two people who cook a lot.

June 12th through November 20th. 24 weeks, \$23 weekly average = \$550

CSA Box- Small Share:

A smaller portion of the farm harvest. Same full spectrum as the full share, but with less volume. Good for small and busy households.

June 12th through November 20th. 24 weeks, \$15 weekly average = \$360

Flower Subscription

Pick up a lovely bouquet for your table too! Our premium bouquets vary every week and feature lilies, roses, pollen-less sunflowers, and many more floral beauties.

July 10th through September 11th; 10 weeks, \$10 weekly = \$100

Market Coupons

Buy a Welcome Table Farm Farmer's Market punch card valued at \$60 for only \$50. Save almost 20% on all you purchases of produce and flowers when punch cards are purchased before April 1st. Redeemable for any 2012 market.

Food with a face- 2012 Meat Offerings:

Here at Welcome Table Farm our animals are treated well. They have personality, names, and our daily respect. They live outdoors and are fed and fattened on the grass, weeds and veggie wastes of the farm. Hormone and antibiotic free. Animal wastes are all composted on site- we couldn't grow veggies without the critters! This is sustainability in practice. Meat reservations will be honored on a first come, first served basis. Please indicate what you would like to buy on the registration form. We will confirm reservations following lambing and farrowing in April. Animals will be slaughtered and

cut and wrap on a custom basis in November by Blue Valley Meats. Prices and pounds listed below are approximations.

Pork, available in May and November by the whole or half hog. Our Large Black hogs are bred, born, and raised here on the farm. They get to socialize with other pigs, wallow in the mud on hot days, and cozy up in the hay on cold days. They are fed and fattened on local garbanzo beans, farm veggie waste, pasture, and fall pumpkins.

Whole hog 100 lbs, dressed weight, kill/cut/wrap- \$160, meat-\$4.50/lb

Lamb, available in November, by the whole.

Our 100% grass-fed, mixed Suffolk, Rambouillet, and Romney flock produces very tender, melt-in-your-mouth good meat.

Whole lamb 30 lbs, dressed weight, kill/cut/wrap- \$85, meat-\$6.00/lb

No poultry for 2012. Meat birds will return in the 2013 season.
